

The Dealer provides a limited warranty for a period of **1 month or 1,000 miles**, whichever occurs first, from the date of delivery.

This warranty applies only to the following major mechanical components:

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| ■ Engine (internal lubricated parts only) | ■ Repair the covered component: |
| ■ Gearbox / transmission (internal lubricated parts only) | ■ Supply replacement reasonable repair costs. |

All warranty repairs must be **authorised** by the Dealer before any work is undertaken.

Warranty Exclusions

Electrical Components

- Batteries
- Starter motors
- Alternators
- Wiring
- Sensors
- ECU modules
- Lighting systems
- Audio/navigation systems
- Electric windows
- Parking sensors
- Air conditioning systems

Wear and Tear Items

- Tyres
- Brakes and brake discs/pads
- Clutch friction material
- Suspension components
- Exhaust systems
- Wiper Blades
- Bulbs
- Filters
- Fluids and lubricants

Seals, Rubber & Cosmetic Items

- Oil seals
- Gaskets
- Rubber hoses
- Plastic trims
- Interior trim
- Pallywork
- Bodywork
- Corrosion/rust
- Water ingress

Customer Responsibilities

- Maintain the vehicle correctly;
- Check oil and coolant levels regularly;
- Stop driving immediately if a fault develops;
- Notify the Dealer promptly of any issue;
- Obtain Dealer approval before repairs are carried out.

No Verbal Guarantees

No employee or representative of the Dealer has authority to provide any warranty or guarantee other than those stated in writing within this agreement.

Inspection & Repair Procedure

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| ■ Inspect the vehicle before approving repairs; | ■ Notify Ford or main; |
| ■ Use reconditioned, used, or aftermarket parts; | ■ Accommodation costs |
| ■ Repair the vehicle at a garage of its choosing. | |

Unauthorised Repairs & Third-Party Garages

- Repairs, inspections or diagnostic work carried out without prior written or verbal authorisation from the Dealer.
- Work completed by third-party garages not approved by the Dealer.
- Labour charges from external repairers unless agreed in advance,

Other Exclusions

- Servicing or routine maintenance
- Timing belts/chains unless failure causes internal engine damage.
- Damage caused by overheating
- Misuse, neglect, racing, abuse or improper use.
- Recovery, towing, storage or transport costs.
- Vehicle hire or alternative transport costs.

The customer must first contact the Dealer and allow the Dealer reasonable opportunity to inspect and repair the vehicle.

Right to Repair

The Dealer reserves the right to repair the vehicle at its own premises and to repair or choose by the Dealer before any refund contribution, or alternative (if any is provided).

The customer must not authorise repairs with another garage without the Dealer's prior consent.

Warranty Void Due to Unauthorised Repairs

Any repair or inspection undertaken, or carried out,
